I understand that you are reproducing this exhibit and making it available to other schools, organizations, and businesses. As such, I would like to offer the following comments/observations with the hope that they may be helpful to prospective recipients of this exhibit:

- The graphic design of the prints is exceptional and a credit to your staff.
- The portability of the exhibit is a useful feature. It can be easily set up, disassembled, and transported in the four shoulder bags. (This will facilitate our sharing this exhibit with other Catholic High Schools in the Diocese of Pittsburgh.)
- The brief narratives on each topic were succinct and well written. The associated images were thoughtfully chosen and visually compelling.
- There was an obvious and successful effort to include perspectives on African American History that are inspirational, specifically- the history of African American music, African American authors, the poetry of Amanda Gorman, the resolve of civil rights activists, and the courage of whites, blacks, men, and women who were the first Freedom Riders.

In sum, I was very impressed by this exhibit, and I strongly endorse your efforts to make it available to other organizations and I wish you success.
